

## HANDLING TRASH

Here are the key the key things to remember regarding how to handle your trash:

Put the bins on either side of your driveway –  
or put them at least **THREE FEET** away from each other

### RECYCLING BIN (blue and yellow):

**\*\*EMPTY, DRY and UNBAGGED ITEMS ONLY!!\*\***

**PLACE ITEMS LOOSE IN CART**

**(Plastic bags, including plastic grocery bags, jam the sorting machinery. They can also be confused for trash since workers can't see inside.)**

### **PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS**

**Labeled #1 - #7      Lids stay on**

### **GLASS BOTTLES & JARS**

**Remove lids or caps**

### **METAL CANS**

**Tin, steel aluminum & empty aerosol cans**

**PAPER – includes junk mail & paperboard-like shoe boxes & cereal boxes**

**CARDBOARD BOXES – flattened!**

### **BLACK BIN:**

**Everything that can't be recycled.**

**This refuse **SHOULD** be bagged.**

**Do NOT put yard waste in the black bin (or the blue one).**

**Yard waste needs to be put in big heavy black plastic bags and put curbside.**

**NOTE: The bins should be put curbside after 7 p.m. on Thursday evening, and should go back beside your house after as soon as possible after pickup, but no later than 7 p.m. on Friday.**

**Electronic Waste: take to 1701 N. Hercules Ave, CW 33765  
on the last Wednesday of every month.**
